


Day-2: Hindi Manthan (Bhavabhivyakthi)

Resource Person: Prof. Stephen I, Faculty, Department of English (PG), Kristu Jayanti College



Objective: To Raise Awareness of Library Resources and Rich Culture of India through the display of books, posters and showcasing the festivals of India.


Brief write up on the session:
