Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>Kristu Jayanti College had a well-established blended learning approach to classroom learning prior to the pandemic. The college could continue education through inbuilt learning management system, interactive video conferencing tool and in-house repositories. The institution was able to maintain equilibrium in regular studies seamlessly during the pandemic adopting the following measures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Kristu Jayanti Learning Management System which enables blended learning through flipped classroom, forums, course management, lesson content, assignment and examinations for equilibrium in learning. 2. Exclusive IT infrastructure for interactive live classrooms and video-conferencing was created. Licensed Zoom platforms with varied capacities were procured. Conferences, webinars, FDPs and academic fests were organized using 1000, 500 and 300 user capacity IDs. The 100 user capacity was used for online classes and mentoring. 3. Google meet, Jiomeet, Microsoft Teams, Cisco WebEx, GoToMeeting and Skype were also used for webinars, classroom interaction, expert lectures and training programmes. 4. Faculty members have created online resources which are uploaded in Jayantian Repository of Information and Sustainable Education (J-RISE) which is the online learning resources portal of the institution. Through J-RISE, classroom learning is supplemented with web and online resources such as video lessons for various courses, links to websites, blogs and YouTube channels 5. Online Facilities of Library : Remote access to learning resources enabling digital access anytime and anywhere. The library has a repository of e-books with remote access facility for faculty and students. The college has subscription to e-journals, database of journals – EBSCO, J-GATE Plus, SAGE with remote access. Infliibnet and Capitaline databases provided research data to the students and faculty. 6. Augmented the Internet capacity by adding another ISP and increasing existing bandwidth of leased line 7. Examinations and continuous internal assessments were conducted as per schedule using the Kristu Jayanti Exam Learning Management System with proctoring supported by dedicated and secured server. 8. Laptops were gifted by the college to the economically backward students to enable them to attend online classes without any difficulty. Provision was made in the campus for students facing internet issues to attend online classes during the pandemic. 9. Exclusive mentoring and Counselling was provided by the class animators to help students with emotional issues during the pandemic. 10. Student development programmes such as life skills education, orientation, soft skill training, academic and cultural fests were organized through online mode. 427 number of student enrichment programmes were conducted during the pandemic.
