
## Report

- 80.88% of alumni members rated that curriculum meet academic interest excellently well.
- 83.84% of members stated that courses taught by the institution enhanced the employment opportunities and higher education opportunity and 15.73% stated that it is good.
- 86.43% of the alumni are of the opinion that the impact that the college has on the professional life is excellent and 13.39% felt it was good.
- 87.05% rated the add-on courses offered by the college to be excellent and 12.4% felt it was good.
- 85.63% are of the opinion that the curriculum offered by the college is excellent and 13.7% rated it as good.
- About the effectiveness of curriculum delivery 86.3% of alumni rated as excellent and 13.2% as very good
- Regarding the fulfilment of programme objectives, 83.28% alumni rated it to be excellent, 15.98% as good
- Feedback on the values and ethics imbibed from the college, 88.28% as excellent 11.54% as good and 0.19% with scope for improvement.
