




## Report

- 86.39% of members stated that courses taught by the institution enhanced the employment opportunities and higher education opportunity and 15.73% stated that it is good.
- 87.13% of the alumni are of the opinion that the impact that the college has on the professional life is excellent and 12.19% felt it was good.
- 87.91% rated the add-on courses offered by the college to be excellent and 11.61% felt it was very good.
- 86.65% are of the opinion that the curriculum offered by the college is excellent and 12.66% rated it as very good.
- About the effectiveness of curriculum delivery 88.75% of alumni rated as excellent and 10.83% as very good
