
KRISTU JAYANTI COLLEGE declared as deemed university

kristu Jayanti College in Bengaluru was officially declared as "Kristu Jayanti Deemed to be University" by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 on Tuesday.

According to a press release, the college previously had autonomous status before the declaration. The institution was established in 1999 to provide higher education and is managed by the Bodhi Niketan Trust of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI). Fr.
