

## Kristu Jayanti School of Management organized Business Quiz in association with Business Standard

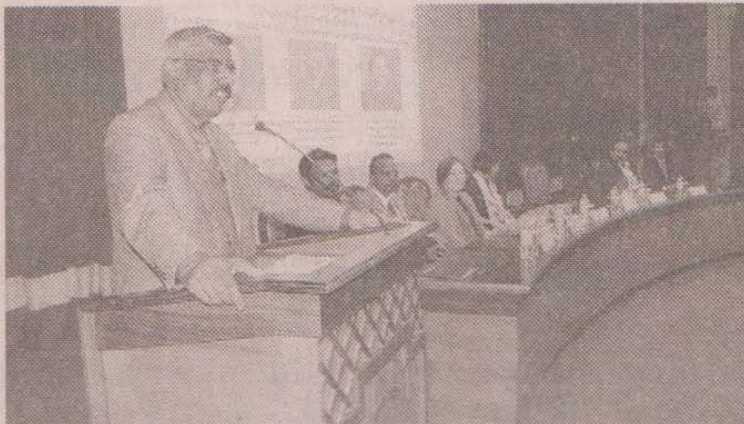
