Value-Added Course (VAC) on Fundamentals of Fintech



The main objective of this course is to supplement students with the technological skills and exposures required for venturing into a new Fintech, InsurTech start-ups.

Technology plays an important role in everybody's life. Meet India's education finance start- ups making learning affordable for millions of students. The Indian Private Equity and Venture Capital Association (IVCA) has identified 'FinTech in Education' as one of the top trends to watch out for. Financial Technology (FINTECH) start-ups in this segment are leading the 'next wave of value creation' in EDTECH. 
International Webinar on "The Future of Accounting Towards Digital Skills in a Transformed World"




DR. YOUSUF AL BULUSHI HIGHLIGHTED THE SIGNIFICANT POINTS IN "THE FUTURE OF ACCOUNTING TOWARD DIGITAL

The resource person for the session was Dr. Yousuf Al Bulushi, Head of Accounting and Finance Business Department at University of Technology and Applied Science, Muscat. He started the session by talking about how automation has changed the front end and back end processes in a firm. The session was continued into how an accountant needs to upgrade their digital skills as the demand for the roles of book keeping and accounting clerks are declining whereas jobs in the field of artificial intelligence, automation and Big Data analysis are the impending trend in the market. These skills can be achieved through mobility programs or training programs that enhance your knowledge of industrial developments. The session covered topics on Transformed Business Model which consists of digital customer experience, intelligent process automation and lean process design. The concept of Big Data was also introduced as to how data has become the new oil - it's valuable, but if unrefined it cannot really be used. An accountant in the digital world requires digital quotient combining strategies and capabilities to remain up to date to the changes in the workplace that this digital transformation brings. The future of accounting would require an accountant to possess potential skills, the awareness and application of digital skills, business skills and technical skills.

The purpose of this workshop was to stimulate the participants and familiarize them with the software.

Very often while conducting a Research there would be a pile load of data and documents from where we would be referring. The researcher has to be strategic, creative, analytical and data-savvy. Mendeley has played a part in making the researcher's job just a little Easier. Mendeley is also an academic social network that enables you to share your research with others. Researcher can collaborate online, in public and private groups, and search for papers in the Mendeley group database of over 30 million papers.



DELIVERING A WELCOME NOTE FOR THE RESOURCE PERSON AND DELEGATES



TWO-DAY WORKSHOP ON CITATION & REFERENCE MANAGEMENT

The resource person for the session was Dr.P.Mathivanan Periasamy , Mendeley Advisor & Assistant Professor, Siva Sivani Institute of Management, Secunderabad. He started the session firstly by asking the participants to download Mendeley and then proceeded. The session was then continued into how a researcher can collect references from the web and UCI Databases, automatically generate citations and Bibliographies, collaborate with other researchers online and access your paper from anywhere online. How the researcher could save time while organizing the files and how when the researcher only remembers the keywords and nothing else about the research paper Mendeley can help the researcher by helping him find the exact research article he is looking for. He demonstrated the following steps:


- ·Search for references in your Mendeley library and insert them into the Document you are working on.
- ·Select and insert Individual or Multiple references at
- ·Create a bibliography of all the references you are cited.
- ·Change to any of your preferred citation styles in just a few clicks.

The first day of the workshop was then concluded with Q&A session and the doubts were cleared by the resource person.

In the second day of the workshop Dr. P. Mathivanan Periasamy taught the participants how they can remove duplicates. He demonstrated the following steps:


- 1.Click on the all documents in the My Library pane on the left
- 2.Click tools and select check for duplicates. A list of all documents that Mendeley identifies as being possible duplicates will be displayed.
- 3. You can merge the duplicate references by clicking on confirm merge in the details pane on the right.
- 4.Double-click on a duplicate to reveal the references Mendeley has identified.
- 5.Click on these identified documents to view their referencing information in the details pane on the right, then compare the information between them.
- 6.Once done, choose either:
- a. Not a duplicate
- b. Merge duplicate

The second day of the workshop was then successfully concluded with Q&A session and the doubts were cleared by the resource person and with a vote of thanks.




