

The session was handled by Prof. Surjit Singha, and Dr. Rajakamal CH, Assistant Professors, Department of Commerce (UG) as resource persons, along with Department Coordinator Prof. Madhu Druvakumar and Staff Coordinator Dr. Akhil M P. The resource persons threw a light on various facets of workshop theme such as citation styles, citation generator, editing and layout designing of an article, citation of journal in APA format, writing a research article, journal reviewers' expectations, and submission process through Mail ID, Author Account and creation of ORCID ID for all the participants.

The participants shared their topics of interest such as field of research in analytics, a complete manuscript, employee performance measurement, performance of researcher, etc. They discussed their topics of interest and raised their queries to the resource persons for the initial idea formation of article drafting, selecting topics, framing of article titles, research paper publication, various websites which provide projects in research fields, and study samples. Sharing of ideas between the trainers and students made the session an interactive one, and the session was highly participative and encouraging towards the students' completion of projects in coming days.

Industrial Visit

The Department of Commerce (PG) organized a One-Day Industrial Visit at KMF, Mandya, Karnataka on 12th September, 2022 for the benefit of I Semester M.Com & M.Com FA Students. A total of 79 students visited the KMF Industry and were escorted by two faculty members- Dr. Cherian Thomas MS and Prof. Bharti Ranade. In the industry, students saw the entire process of manufacturing milk and milk products. This included the process of collecting milk from nearby villages in 10,000 to 15000 litre capacity tankers, which were then chilled and unloaded in the first compartment of the factory building. The milk collected was then sent into the factory for pasteurization and was packed into 1/4th, ½ and 1 litre packets and chilled in a refrigerator in the second and third compartments respectively.

They also produce milk powder which is shipped out in batches of 1,250 kgs with each single unit weighing 25 kgs. They also produce butter, ghee and some sweets in different compartments of the factory. The whole pasteurization process is powered by steam produced in boiler rooms with the help of coal. This IV has provided the student fraternity with a practical real-business world perspective on different functions of KMF such as Marketing, HR, Finance, Operations, Customer Service, Logistics Management, Inventory Management, etc. This IV aims to bridge the gap between the academic curriculum and the industry.


