Commercia 2K24



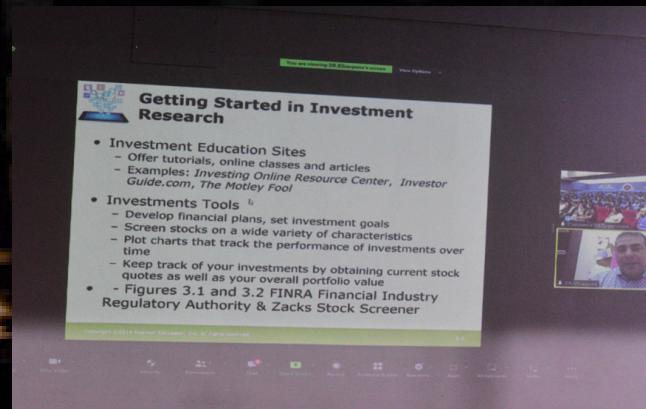

The Department of Commerce (PG) organized a Two-Days International Conference on “Proliferation of business & commerce in the light of fintech: growth, opportunities & challenges” on 27th & 28th February, 2024 at A3 Auditorium, 5th Floor, Admin Block. Rural Exposure



The Department of Commerce PG integrated a Rural Exposure Program into the MCom and MCom FA curriculum, awarding 2 credits to participating students. Themed "GRAMA SAMVEDITA," the program, held over two days in Nagayanna Koppli, Uthenahalli, and Janenahalli village, Shrivaniabelgola, Hassan District on March 25th and 26th, 2024, saw enthusiastic participation from faculty members like Dr. Pushpa A, Dr. Cherian Thomas, and Dr. Vidhya S. Divided into teams, students engaged in activities spanning Cooking & Cleaning, Survey & Awareness, Activities, and Tech.

The program's objectives included evaluating the impact of government schemes on rural communities, focusing on Women Empowerment (GRUHA LAKSHMI scheme), Unemployment (MGNREGA), Education (Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan), and Farmers' Welfare. Surveys conducted in Uthenahalli and Janenahalli provided insights into scheme awareness and effectiveness. Additionally, students undertook trekking for cleanliness campaigns and organized competitions for school children at a local government school.

In terms of practical skills, students showcased competence in cooking and cleaning, highlighting the importance of mastering these essential life skills. Furthermore, the program emphasized the often-overlooked contribution of accommodation staff to guest comfort and well-being, fostering gratitude and mutual appreciation. Approximately 38 members assisted in cooking, including washing and cutting vegetables, while 8 to 10 members aided in utensil washing over the two days. The program's learning outcomes were aimed at enhancing students' personal and professional skills, including planning, organizing, executing, recording, and report writing, thereby contributing to their overall self-development.



Industrial Visit

2nd Sem M.Com and M.Com FA students were allowed to interact with real-life scholars who preserve decades-old manuscripts at the mint condition and learn the method of preservation of such inscriptions on the palm leaves- using oils such as neem oil, and clove oil, of these categories which prevented damages. Also, the inking process was mentioned to the students in a simple and comprehensive language.

The manuscripts preserved and maintained by the centre had information dating back to 7th century, stands as an early example of poetic writing in Kannada. It praises the revered saint Nandisena and his ascent to the heavenly realm, emphasizing his significance in Jain religious practices at Shravanabelagola.

Students were also given the opportunity to hold & see these manuscripts for the first time. They were also allowed inside the library to look into Collection. Some books were also put up for sale. The interaction between the staff and the students had given them an enriching experience.
