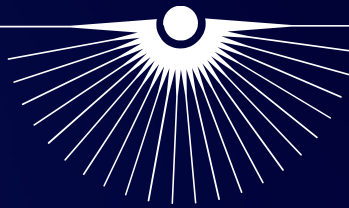

WHAT'S IN THE AIR FOR APPLE?



Is existence an achievable reality or a far-fetched dream for Apple in the next 50 years?

Sticking to one's ideals and beliefs is very important these days and Steve Jobs is one such individual who stood firm in what he truly believes in. His comeback after a decade into his company after being cast out is a story that I would rather listen to literally a hundred times. "Loving what you do and if you don't find it keep searching for it" is a famous saying of his, which was given by him to the Stanford Graduates. But the question at hand is how long will Jobs' ideology survive? After the sad passing of Steve on October 5th 2011 the company has managed to move forward with pricing and marketing strategies that was previously followed and implemented. Other companies like Oneplus and Samsung have so much to offer in terms of features, design and pricing policy. The utility that the consumers gets from purchasing their products, even if it is an older model, is something to be considered by Apple's competitors. The Indian market is now owned by Android phone companies. They have realized the potentiality of the Indian market and the mindset of its consumers. These days it isn't a big thing as it very easy to get a phone with dual camera and a good processor between the price range of Rs 10,000 to Rs12,000, but getting a phone with all the features at a lower price range is what the Indian consumers want and the companies have realized it and henceforth exploited this opportunity. Purchasing an iPhone in India will allow the individual to purchase another iPhone in the U.S. Which means that the cost incurred to purchase an iPhone in India is almost double.

Coming to the laptop or Personal desktop sector tech, companies like Dell and HP have been offering personal computers at an affordable price for quite some time now. Jobs began his Keynote Address for introduction of the Macbook Air in the year 2008 by saying "There is Something in the Air". Ever since that year, to this very day Macbook Air has been their most sold product for the company as it provides a notebook with Apple environment at a particularly cheaper rate. Being able to afford an iPhone or a Macbook Pro is not possible for many people. 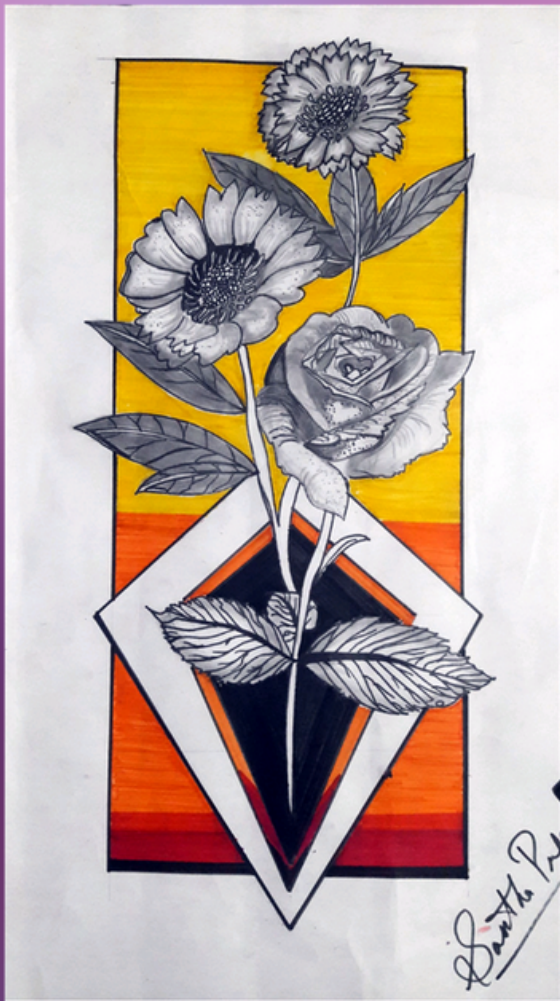
