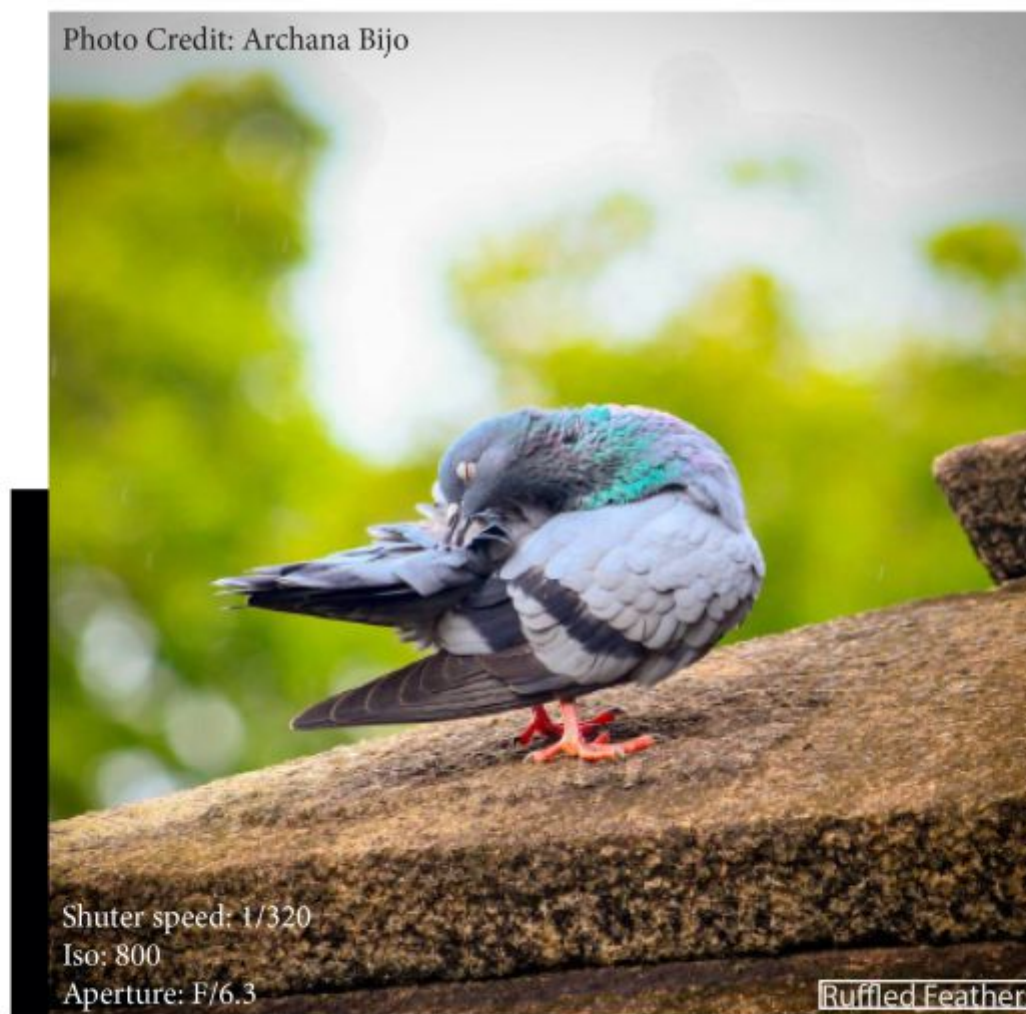

Ruffled Feathers

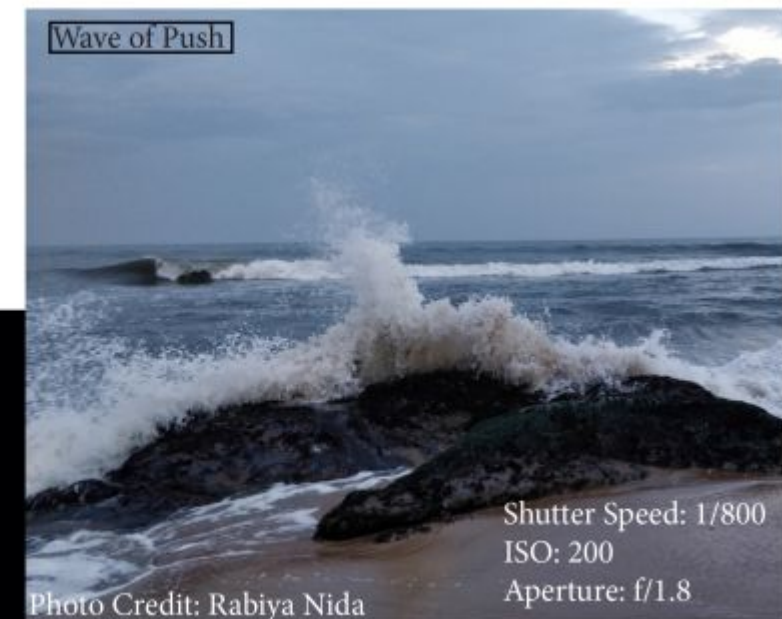

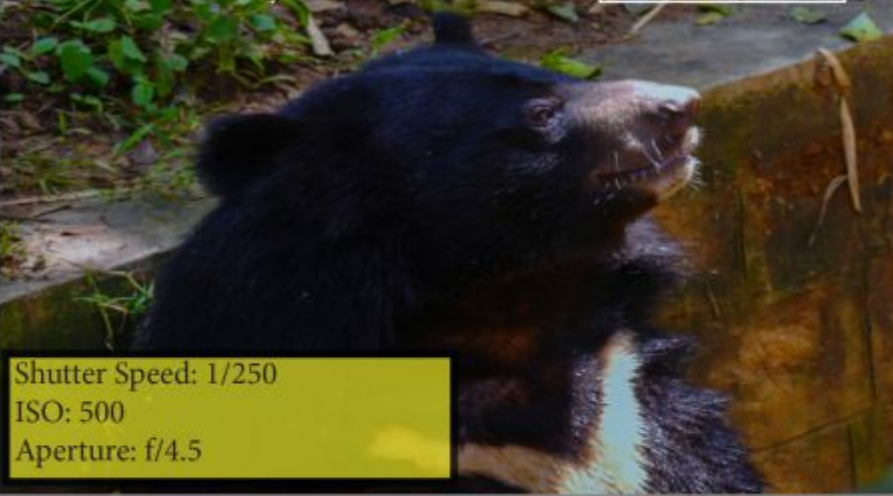
