The expansive plateau spreads like a natural amphitheatre, with three strategically placed watchtowers beckoning tourists to various vantage points. From these vantage points, one is treated to a stunning panoramic view of Mahabaleshwar, which reveals its lush valleys, dense forests, and undulating hills in a natural symphony.

Kerala backwaters are a network of brackish lagoons and canals lying parallel to the Arabian Sea of the Malabar coast of Kerala state in south-western India. It also includes interconnected lakes, rivers, and inlets, a labyrinthine system formed by more than 900 km ( 560 mi ) of waterways, and sometimes compared to bayous. The network includes five large lakes linked by canals, both man made and natural, fed by 38 rivers, and extending virtually half the length of Kerala state. Kettuvallam (Kerala houseboats) in the backwaters are one of the prominent tourist attractions in Kerala. More than 2,000 of these ply the waterways. The Kerala government has classified the tourist houseboats as platinum, gold, and silver. The backwaters near my ancestral home in Karunagapally, Kollam, Kerala.
