- The paper should include the title, author's name, mailing address, mobile number and e-mail address
- The paper should be based on an original research work that has not been published
- The abstract and full paper should be submitted on or before 31st October, 2018 to <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=icon2018>
- When a paper is submitted by more than one author, all authors have to register and be present during the conference
- Certificates will be issued only on the second day of the Conference after the valedictory ceremony
- The papers submitted to the 10th I-Con would be peer reviewed and published in the Journal of All India Association for Educational Research (AIAER), an UGC approved journal : ISSN 0970 9827
