- When a paper is submitted by more than one author, all authors have to register and be present during the conference
- Certificates will be issued only on the second day of the Conference after the valedictory ceremony
- The papers submitted to I-Con 2018 would be peer reviewed and published in the **International Journal of Higher Education and Research (IJHER)**, an UGC approved journal (Serial No. 48406); ISSN 2277 260X.
