Research Quest

Research and innovation are the pillars of future sustainability and the global quality of our institution. Realising this great need, the Centre for Research aspires to reach global benchmarks by setting various targets for its research quest. A 5 P model is adopted to promote research at the institution – policy, projects, publications, patents, and progress. The Research Promotion Policy of the institution propels the faculty and the students to foray into path-breaking research in diverse disciplines. The Centre for Research provides a support system to undertake externally funded (Government / Non-Government / Private Agencies) and institutional funded research projects. Faculty members are encouraged to publish their research in quality, indexed journals and improve their citations and H-index. The college also publishes five research journals. The Intellectual Property Advisory Cell provides assistance in applying for and obtaining patents. The faculty research contribution is monitored by the Centre to assess the progress and career advancements of the faculty members.



Publications – Pathway to Knowledge Creation

The Research footprint of an institution is measured by the quality of its research publications guided by the benchmarks set by the Centre and motivated by the research empowerment strategies of the institution. The faculty members publish their research findings in high impact journals. Due diligence is kept to maintain academic integrity and avoid cloned and predatory journals. Workshops, Faculty Development Programmes and Colloquiums serve as channels of research enhancement. All departments organise conferences and seminars to disseminate research information. The research output has witnessed a manifold increase in the last five years. The research publications in Scopus, WoS, UGC CARE listed journals increased from 54 publications in 2015-2016 to 362 publications in 2020-2021. Books, chapters in books and proceedings increased from 66 in 2016 to 214 in 2020.



Shodh Pravartan

Research projects funded by Government / Non-Government institutions have been pursued by the faculty members. Rs. 48.8 lakhs have been received as a research grant from external agencies. Shodh Pravartan Research Grant Scheme is an institutional initiative to encourage faculty members to under-take research projects. The research grant is provided in three categories: i) Minor Research Project for research in specific disciplines and trans-disciplines, ii) Collaborative Community Project for socio-economic development of local community and iii) United Nations Sustainable Development Goal Project for poverty alleviation. The Centre formulates the guidelines, calls for proposals, conducts expert reviews and sanctions the projects. Periodic review and monitoring are also done systematically to ensure scientific adeptness. Thirteen MRP and twenty-four CCP have been completed. The centre has received sixty-three proposals in the current academic year.



Patents – Reservoir of Intellectual Property

Patents – Reservoir of Intellectual Property

The Faculty of the institution are encouraged to create intellectual property. Guidance and support provided by the IPA Cell facilitate the filing of patents and copyrights. IPR workshops and seminars are organised to orient faculty members on the patent filing process. Multidisciplinary collaborations are forged and innovations are patented in various departments. The institution has both Indian and International patents to its credit. The faculty has published 24 patents, filed five patents, registered one patent and submitted two copyrights.



Seed Money for Research

Seed Money for Research Scheme has been instituted to benefit faculty members of Kristu Jayanti College to provide financial assistance to undertake research. The Centre formulates relevant guidelines for the provision of seed money. The guidelines are revised every year and approved by institutional committees and management. Research output in the form of publications and patents are eligible for the grant. An expert committee reviews the quality and integrity of the research work before recommending the sanction of seed money. A sum of Rs.25 lakhs was provided as seed money during the last five years. The seed money granted by the institution has increased from Rs. 1.09 lakhs to Rs. 17.43 lakhs.

Research Empowerment Programmes

The pursuit of knowledge is incomplete without constant updation. The academic calibre of a teacher needs to be enhanced through continuous reskilling and upskilling. Research empowerment programmes serve as staircases of professional development of faculty members. Diverse categories of workshops, faculty development programmes and interactive sessions are organised to sharpen their research skills. The themes for the sessions range from basic research methodology to the usage of advanced analytical tools. Orientation and guidance are also provided on the identification of the right journal for publication. Collaboration with eminent research institutions across the nation is encouraged.

ಅನುಸंधान केंद्र

किसी भी शैक्षिक संस्थान में अनुसंधान केंद्र, उस संस्थान को एक उच्च स्थान पर ले जाने वाली सीढ़ी होती है। यह अनुसंधान सीढ़ी समाज के परिवर्तन की दिशा में योगदान तथा शोध को बढ़ावा देता है। इसके साथ ही अनुकूल भौतिक और बौद्धिक वातावरण के ढांचे में डालकर उसे योग्यता के शिखर की ओर ले जाने की कार्य करती है। इसी राह पर क्रिस्तु जंयती महाविद्यालय (स्वायत्त) में "अनुसंधान केंद्र" का स्थान है। शोधकर्ता ईमानदारी, पारदर्शिता, जवाबदेही और दूरदर्शिता के नैतिक मूल्यों के साथ सभी अनुसंधान कार्यों में यू.जी.सी. के नैतिक मानकों का पालन करते हुए कार्यरत हैं। अनुसंधान केंद्र में सभी विभाग के शोध कर्ताओं के द्वारा संपन्न शोध-कार्य किया जा रहा है। इस अनुसंधान केंद्र के विकास में पिछले पाँच वर्षों (2015 से 2020) में वृद्धि दिखाई देती है, जैसे - शोध परियोजना में 2015 में 05 थे, 2020 में 18 तक हुए वहीं शोध आलेखों में 54 थे 362 हुए और पुस्तकें एवं पुस्तक अध्यायों में 66 थे 214 हुए हैं।
