The event showcases the best of Successful Young Indian Entrepreneurs who will share their experiences, challenges and methods to become successful entrepreneurs.

3. E- Stores

Activities

Students selected on the basis of the business proposal submitted, will be motivated to put stalls in the food court, once in a week. The activity will be performed throughout the semester with only two members per team. This is aimed at helping the students to inculcate and improve their entrepreneurial skills and give hands-on experience of business to the students.

Resource persons from various fields are invited to address the students on various aspects of entrepreneurship to provide additional knowledge and encouragement to students to embark on their entrepreneurial journey.

Write Up

Keeping this in mind, the Entrepreneurship Cell (Luminary) of Kristu Jayanti College (Autonomous) has taken the initiative to come with E-Store. The Cell provides opportunity to two students every week to exhibit their entrepreneurial skills by coming up with a creative stall and sell products the whole day in the college campus.

Odd Semester

With the start of an exciting new year at Kristu Jayanti College, the Entrepreneurship Development Cell brought forth yet another hands-on, fun and learning filled edition of the E-Store. It was held on the Thursdays of every week from September 15 to October 15 wherein there were 2 participants from each team that would get a chance to carry out a business activity

for a day on the specified date in the campus. The profits arising from this venture was the reward for the participants.

Vasanth and Asma from 3rd Semester B.Com had opened up a food joint on 17th September, 2015 that served PaniPuri, Chaats and Brownies. They had made a considerable amount of profit after getting back their investment. Sonia and Vishnu from the 5th Semester BBM, had also opened a food joint on 23rd September 2015 that offered a unique product called the Banoffee pie (banana and toffee) that were completely sold out along with some sandwiches and lemon juice. Heera and Jaisri from 5th Semester B.B.M had opened up a store on 7th October, 2015 that had jewelry made from paper and was hand crafted. The stall had a good collection of earrings, necklaces and show pieces. Faizan and Vinita from the 3rd BBM had opened up a food joint on 22nd October, 2015 that served burgers and parottas with curries and juices. Dillyn and Hannah from the 1st Semester B. Sc, had opened up a store on 29th October, 2015 that offered fried chicken wings along with brownies and even though they were new inexperienced freshers, they made the maximum profit among all the teams, by putting their skills on the plate.

Sonia and Sweety of VI BBM displayed and sold delicacies like Banana pie, cupcakes, and beef chutney along with some accessories in their store called as "O My Mouth". The last store for the academic year 2015-16 was put up by Daveen and Jansi of II B.Com on 5th April 2016 where they sold desserts from their own Start-up.

Each student had a different energy and vibe to them but the one common thing they all had was the passion to have their own Start-up or to develop and grow their start-ups. All the students of KJC promoted E-store with open heart and everyone had positive feedback. E-stores ended with a hope to experience it again in the next academic year



On the fifth day “Travail Creatif” was conducted where students had to make a short film on how an entrepreneur in an individual is born.




The students were really inspired and took part in the activities organized by Mr. Nouman, in which they had to come up with their own start up ideas and present it in front of everyone.
