






Overview:



The objective of the orientation program is to give an adequate knowledge about Karnataka Civil Defence Corps to the 1st year students of Kristu Jayanti College.


Overview:

"Freedom in the mind, strength in our words, pureness in our blood, pride in our souls, zeal in our hearts, let's salute our India on Republic Day".




To train the volunteers KCDC club is organising a training program on psychological first aid.





Karnataka Civil Defence Corps (KCDC) Ministry of Home Affairs

The Civil Defence Corps, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, was established in May 1968 after Parliament passed The Civil Defence Act, 1968 (Act 27 of 1968). Civil Defence is designed to respond to immediate emergency situations, protect the public, and restore vital services and facilities that have been destroyed or damaged by disaster. The Act covers the entire country and includes provisions for non-combatant measures such as providing protection to any person, property, place, or thing in India or any part of its territory against any hostile attack, whether from the air, land, sea, or other places, or depriving any such attack of the whole or part of its effects, whether such measures are taken before, during, or after the attack. It also authorized the raising of Civil Defence Corps and for making Rules and Regulations for Civil Defence.

At the national level, the Director General, Civil Defence under the Ministry of Home

Affairs (MHA) is responsible for formulating Civil Defence policies and for coordination. In the states, the Civil Defence set- up is headed by a senior police officer designated as the Director, Civil Defence. At the district level, the District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP) of a district is designated Controller of Civil Defence.

Kristu Jayanti College student volunteers are part of KCDC Division 64 as Civil Defence Corps members. Civil Defence volunteers are guided by divisional warden to involve in rescue, rehabilitation and relief work – effects of war.

Objectives

- To attract more volunteers to KCDC to serve the country.
- To enlighten the public about the services rendered by the department during crisis.
- To protect life and property of general public during war or natural calamities.

Objectives:

1. To create awareness among first year volunteers the basic outline of the structure, functions, and hierarchy of Karnataka Civil Defence Corps.

Overview:

Karnataka Civil Defence Corps unit of Kristu Jayanti College Autonomous, organized an Orientation session for the newly registered I Year Volunteers on 10th September 2022 in M3 Auditorium, Main Block of the college campus. Mr. Job P Samuel, Deputy Post Warden, Division 60, Karnataka Civil Defence Corps oriented on specialized training in collapse, organisations structure, search and Rescue. Sir differentiated between a "CD warden" and a "CD volunteer" and then went on to share his journey from a volunteer to a warden. Sir spoke about his experience in the Division citing many personal anecdotes and highlighting the roles and responsibilities of a civil defence volunteer. This was followed by a Q & A session, where sir efficiently answered all the questions posed by the volunteers.

The faculty coordinator Prof Manjunath S expressed his gratitude to Mr Job P Samuel for taking time from his busy schedule and addressing the young volunteers marking the conclusion of the session. 
Outcome:




Overview:


