Objective: The main aim of the campaign is to encourage rainwater harvesting

Brief Write up on the Programme:

Environment Club in association with Centre for Social Activities organized a Guest Lecture on “Rain water Harvesting” on 12th September 2019. The Guest Speaker was Prof. Vishwanath Srikantaiah, Adjunct Professor, Ajim Premji University, Bengaluru popularly called as “ZENRAINMAN”. He has 33 years of experience in water conservation and ecofriendly construction. Prof. Vishwanath Srikantaiah was member of WHO advisory committee on water conservation. In his lecture Prof. Vishwanath Srikantaiah rain water harvesting shared his expertise on the present water crisis in the world . He educated students about various types of water bodies and water storage structure that once existed in India in ensuring the water management. Prof Srikantaiah gave an overview of the water resources of modern India enabling the students to get a picture of various water resources. He enlightened the students about the excessive misuse of water resources especially ground water due to the excessive increase in surplus population, food grain production and electricity generation. Prof. Srikantaiah brought into focus about the need to revive or rejuvenate wells, borwells to conserve water. He urged the students to do their bit in preserving and conservation of water bodies for the welfare of the society. He elaborated different ways of rainwater harvesting and its installations. The students deemed the lecture as very good learning experience which helped them to understand the importance of water conservation at domestic level. The expert talk sensitized students about the problems of water scarcity in India and served as an impetus in order to fight this menace. During the interactive session, students also raised their concerns on Environment issues in Bangalore.


Brief Write up on the Programme:

Objective: To monitor, check and reduce electricity and water usage in campus of Kristu Jayanti College, Bengaluru

Brief Write up on the Programme:

Saving electricity reduces the amount of carbon dioxide released into the atmosphere. Energy efficiency is widely hailed as a key component of slowing global warming. Electricity obtained from solar and wind power means use less amount of fossil fuels. Most of the electricity used in homes comes from the burning of fossil fuels such as oil or coal. These fuels are needed to power the turbines that produce electricity. These resources are not unlimited or renewable; the faster they are used and the more electricity that is consumed, the quicker they will be depleted.

Students of the Environment Club associated with the Department of Life Sciences have taken an initiative to check the usage of electricity and water in our campus. 130 students have been involved in this programme. The environment brigade of students began monitoring electricity and water usage from 13th January 2020. The students from 2nd and 4th semester were assigned class rooms and wash rooms which they had to check during lunch and after 4:30pm. They were made into six groups. 58 class rooms and 11 wash rooms were checked every day. Each day one group was assigned to check the campus. At the end of the day, a representative from the respective group submitted a report on the programme to the student coordinators.

Two leaking taps were noticed and repaired. The taps that were open were taken care. The classrooms that left lights and fans switched on continuously were noticed and informed to switch it off. Projectors that were on when not used were asked to switch it off. The effort by the

environment brigades helped in saving electricity and water in a major way and spread awareness among students to save the resource available.



Brief Write up on the Programme:

The Life Sciences Department organized a Social Extension Programme on 7th March, 2020. Ten students of first year M.Sc. Biotechnology and Microbiology students selected by the department were accompanied by Dr. Hanumanthapa B. Nayaka and NSS Volunteers, and the NSS Faculty in charge Mr. Sreedhar.

A large number of the Local farmers from nearby villages had gathered and farmers were educated about the hazards of using chemical fertilizers and advantages of using biofertilizers that was produced by the Solid wastes. Report on the programme:

Biofertilizers are substance that contains microorganism's living or latent cells. Biofertilizers increase the nutrients of host plants when applied to their seeds, plant surface or soil by colonizing the rhizosphere of the plant. Biofertilizers are more cost-effective as compared to chemical fertilizers. The microorganisms in biofertilizers restore the soil's natural nutrient cycle and build soil organic matter. One of the major advantages of such fertilizer is that it does not harm the environment or in other words it's environment-friendly.

Hence the present trial was practiced to evaluate the efficacy of biofertilizer consortium developed in the Biotechnology Research Laboratory of Kristu Jayanti College and tested in field provided by Alamba charitable trust, Gubbicross, Bangalore Rural district of Karnataka;

Objectives

- ✓ An alternative eco-friendly approach for sustainable agricultural practices to frequent use of organic and microbial biofertilizers.

- ✓ To reclamate and improve the fertility of the soil and crop productivity.

The Context

Vegetative parameters of cultivated crops were observed healthy with minimal pests attack. Planted crops started yielding. Harvesting was done thrice.

The Practice

Beneficial microorganisms such as *Rhizobium sp.*, was isolated from the root nodules of legumes; *Azotobacter sp.*, and phoshosphobacteria were isolated from the soil respectively. They were mass prodced, mixed in right proportions and then injected into carrier material (peat) to prepare biofertilizer consortium. Similary, vermicompost harvesred from college canteen wastes also added as a root study.

Crops tested

1. **Tomato**
2. **Brinjal**
3. **Chilli**
4. **Spinach**

Evidence of Success

Since two years, the field has been in our lab to land practice, the fertility of the field (soil) was observed very good and become highly productive. Soil fertility, water porosity, nature, color and aeration of the field were observed very good.

Brief write up of the Programme:

Prof. Nandini enlightened on how Bangalore, once known as Garden City has changed over the years and stressed on the necessity to have sustainable development. She explained about how lakes play a major role in our lives and that we have a moral responsibility to protect and preserve them. She showed the photographs of different lakes in Bangalore and explained how they have changed due to human encroachment. When we pollute nature it comes back to us. She took a case study of Vrishabhavathi river and Bellandur lake and explained how pollution has drastically changed the water quality. Water pollution in turn affect fishes and causes water borne diseases as we consume them. Heavy metal accumulation has been witnessed near construction areas and there has been cases of cross contamination of sewage leading to diseases in lake view apartments where lake encroachment has been done.

India is one of the 12 mega biodiversity of world. Dr. Nandini elaborated on how her group has made an eco-friendly herbal hand sanitizer using native plants like turmeric and Neem.


It is important to grow native trees like Pongamia Pinnata (Pongam), Tamarindus Indica (Tamarind), Azadirachta indica (Neem Tree) and Heritage trees like Banyan tree, Coconut Trees, Jack Fruit Trees, Rain Trees, Peepal Trees. There are many number of Aquatic species which could purify heavy metals in water. Growing Typha plant around water bodies help in bioremediation. There many varieties of bacteria which aid in Bioremediation and Phyto remediation. Phyto plankton Chlorella Vulgaris and Zoo plankton-Benthos have a great role to play. Insects have a major role in maintaining the ecosystem. Odonates, Butterflies, Fishes, Frogs, Reptiles and Birds are part of biodiversity and have specific roles to play in the balance of ecosystem. The plant Dark Blue Tiger has been found to attract Butterflies.

Dr. Nandini concluded the session by saying that if biodiversity is conserved automatically, water bodies will be purified. If we protect Nature, it will protect you back.


Brief write up of the Programme:


