GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

1. The paper should be based on original research work not yet published or not considered for publication elsewhere. It should not exceed 5000 words or 12 pages. If the paper has been sent for publication elsewhere, the fact must be declared.
2. Authors should take responsibility for issues related to plagiarism.
3. The first page should include the title, name of author(s), affiliation, mailing address, telephone number and e-mail address.
4. The abstract should be submitted on or before 25/02/2022 and full paper should be mailed to wec@kristujayanti.com on or before 05/03/2022. Abstract submitted after the due date will not be included in Abstract proceedings book.
5. Research papers submitted after 05/03/2022 will not be considered for publication.
6. Soft copy should be submitted in A4 Size, MS word format only with Times New Roman font with heading in font size 14 and remaining text of size 12 with spacing 1.5 as a single line.
7. Participation/Presentation of paper should be confirmed on or before 07/03/2022, by sending the completed Registration form along with the registration Fee.
8. All joint participants must register individually and physically participate for the paper presentation to be considered as a part of the conference.
9. E-Certificates will be issued to all the registered participants after attending the conference.
10. Certificate of Participation will be awarded only to those participants who attend all the sessions of the conference.

PUBLICATION

The selected papers will be peer reviewed and evaluated based on originality and relevance to the conference. Selected papers of high quality will be published in Scopus Indexed Journal or proceedings book with ISBN with an additional payment.
