About the College

With the motto "Educate and Empower", the cell organizes various activities throughout the year which include annual conferences, workshops, guest lectures and awareness programmes on the current social issues faced by women for the betterment of the society. About the Conference

The conference titled Intersecting Public-Private Schisms in the 21st Century: Engendering the Everyday explores gender identities from multiple perspectives accounting for categories of identity and agency in the present times. Since subjectivities are many, many causes for it, it is increasingly complicated to determine the range of subject positions, its many interpolations and social practices that formulate gender identities. Subjectivities can be marked as 'narrative, story, or history, it is constructed, told, spoken, not simply found'. Identity is an invention 'which is never complete'. Any conversation around gender becomes complicit with categories of caste, class, and race to name a few and many other liminal intersections that are tacit, awaiting articulation. Feminist thinking in its formative stages drew on subject matter that ranged across notions of 'feminist aesthetics', 'anxiety of authorship', political differences and conflicts of interest among women of colour and white women, compulsory heterosexuality, the instability and arbitrariness of binaries and criminalization of binaries to name a few. While these struggles are real, they play out quite differently at the micro-level, 'locally' and at the macro-level, 'globally'. Since gender intersects with several other identity categories narratives that come out of these struggles are quite exclusive coagulating into media that deserve expression. This conference brings together experiences that are public and private that interweave in unimagined ways, engendering the 'every day'. The 'Every day' as a "productive problem" is an idea established in sociological literature, understanding the 'everyday' in engendered terms reconfigures experiences that are otherwise naturalized as mundane and not worthy of attention.

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

1. The paper should be based on original research work not yet published or not considered for publication elsewhere. It should not exceed 5000 words or 12 pages. If the paper has been sent for publication elsewhere, the fact must be declared.
2. Authors should take responsibility for issues related to plagiarism.
3. The first page should include the title, name of author(s), affiliation, mailing address, telephone number and e-mail address.
4. The abstract should be submitted on or before 1st March 2024 and the full paper should be mailed to wec@kristujayanti.com on or before 13th March 2024. Abstracts submitted after the due date will not be included in the Abstract book.
5. Research papers submitted after 13th March 2024 will not be considered for publication.
6. A soft copy of the abstract should be submitted in A4 Size in MS Word format only with Times New Roman font with a heading in font size 14 and remaining text of size 12 with spacing of 1.5 as a single line.
7. Participation/Presentation of paper should be confirmed on or before 13th March 2024, by sending the completed Registration form along with the Registration Fee.
8. All joint participants must register individually and physically participate in the paper presentation to be considered as a part of the conference.
9. E-certificates will be issued to all the registered online participants after a week of attending the conference.
10. Certificate of Participation will be awarded only to those participants who attend all the sessions of the conference.
11. Papers presented during the conference only will be considered for publication.

PUBLICATION

The selected papers will be peer-reviewed and evaluated based on originality and relevance to the conference. Selected papers of high quality will be published in an edited book with an ISBN for an additional payment. Information about the acceptance of papers will be mailed to the main author within 15 days if the paper is received before the due date. ISBN book publication will be done based on the quality of the paper with the consent of the authors. The decision of the reviewing committee is final in this regard.
