



### THE ELIXIR OF INSPIRING FREEDOM

The fifteenth of August 2021, the 75th year of Independence was celebrated as 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav'. What do you mean by 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav'? It testifies to the elixir of the energy of Independence. This phrase finds its place in the core of the elixir of inspirations. It was the undying inspirations of our freedom fighters that gave them the energy and courage to achieve what we have today, Independence. This Independence Day was a reminder, not to forget the known and the unsung heroes of freedom, a reminder of the revolution which arose from high-held dignity and burning love for the nation. A revolutionary woman who was exposed to the tumult that existed among humanity as a young girl. This little girl was none other than Captain Lakshmi Sahgal, the commander of The Rani of Jhansi Regiment. I would like to introduce this honorable woman born on 24th October, 1914, as 'My Inspiration'. Captain Lakshmi writes," My introduction to political life came through my mother and her commitment to social revolution". This points out to an indication that Capt. Lakshmi was exposed to the influence of powerful women from a young age, the first being her very own mother and then moving forward to prominent women like Comrade Suhasini Nambiar (the first Indian woman to become a member of the Communist party). Her course of life as a doctor changed through a meeting with Subhash Chandra Bose, a man who was instrumental in empowering women from all backgrounds to fight for the nation.

Capt. Lakshmi was a very selfless woman, she tended to the needs of the injured while fighting for the nation side by side, but above all it was her idea of freedom that inspired me the most. She said," Freedom comes in three forms, the first is political emancipation from the conqueror, the second is economic (emancipation) and the third is social... India has only achieved the first". This tells us that she didn't restrict her idea of freedom and furthermore, only highlighted that freedom goes way beyond just physical liberation. Her vision of freedom was a nation free from the economic and social oppression as well. A nation that is in the shackles of these oppressions is good as still being under slavery. Capt. Lakshmi saw a free India, a nation free from all such chains, a democratic nation where every individual benefits from the fruits of hard work. She worked for the freedom of women even after independence as she was horrified at the inhuman treatment like Sati, female feticide etc. that they received despite Independence. So she became one of the founding members and the Vice president of The All India Democratic Women's Association (AIDWA), the largest women's organization in India. The point is, she didn't just sit thinking of the poor plight of women, instead she took action which brought in results. This would be a specific event that inspired me among several others.

Many a times we want for a change to take place, but we need to ask ourselves "What are we doing about it? Would only a desire bring about a change?" It is time we get up and do something about the change we want to see like Capt. Lakshmi. I quote Mahatma Gandhi, 'be the change you wish to see in the world'. The Change starts with you. Thus I would like to reinforce why Capt. Lakshmi Sahgal is my inspiration, simply because she was an empowering woman whose vision of freedom had no boundaries, a woman that took action to witness the change she wanted to see. India with no doubt is witnessing a change since the roots of Independence in 1947, but the baton of a better change is being passed down to the coming generation. Therefore, we the youth, being a part of that change have the responsibility of continuing this process so that India will soon witness the true meaning of freedom. A vision that our freedom fighters had when they laid down their lives so that we would be able to experience what real freedom is. This again starts with every single one of us that will be instrumental in achieving this vision.

Our goal is freedom, but it is important to have the right perspective of the goal we want to achieve. I would like to let you in on what real freedom means to me. According to me real freedom is the freedom of 'The Mind'. The Mind of a man, is where it all starts, from innovations and good thoughts in every field etc. Therefore we need to train and develop our minds into instruments that will influence and change other minds. It is only when all minds are aligned with the same idea of what freedom should really mean, will the body start reacting accordingly and takes action. To me, freedom means to free the mind from evil thoughts and to be more broad-minded because the mind gives birth to what we are and what we will turn out to be in the future. A free mind is a free individual and a nation of free minds is a free nation. These are the minds that will lead the nation to a better tomorrow, a better India which will become a paradise for the people living in this nation. Gitanjali 35 by Rabindranath Tagore 'Where the Mind is Without Fear' only reinforces the power of the mind, the power to create or destroy. He concludes by praying, 'into that heaven of freedom, my Father, let my country awake'. Therefore I urge every person to start working towards a free India, so that a baby born tomorrow may open its eyes to freedom and not to oppression and exploitation. We, as responsible citizens will continue the fight of our ancestors to achieve a free nation, a paradise that we will hopefully live to witness one day, just like the song 'One Day' by Matisyahu. Until then let us keep working, keep pursuing and keep praying that we may soon realize the fruit of freedom from all the struggle and hard work for a better and brighter tomorrow. May Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav be the start of this change.
